On this the 25th day of July, 1910, came on to be considered the return of an Election held on the 9th day of July, 1910 in Common School District No. 1 of this County upon the question of determining whether or not a special tax of 25% on the \$100.00 valuation of all property in said District subject to taxation shall be levied and collected for the purpose of supplementing the State School fund and it appearing that said Election was in all respects legally held and that said returns were duly and legally made and that there were cast at said Election 23 votes, of which number there were cast

For the School Tax 21 votes

Against the School Tax 2 votes

and it appearing to the Court from said returns that a majority of the qualified property tax paying voters of said District voting at said election, voted in favor of said Tax, the Court does hereby declare the said Tax to have carried in said District, and that this Court is authorized to levy and have assessed and collected said Tax.
