It is ordered that the contract for the boring of an
Artesian Well on the Public Square in Kemp Hill be
let to D. A. Smith as per the contract and specifications
following:

The State of Texas } I know all men by these presents that
County of Sabine } this contract entered into by and between
The Sabine County Commissioners of Sabine County, Texas,
parties of the first part, and D. A. Smith, parties of the second
part witnesses. That party of the first part agree to pay party
of the second part for the drilling of an Artesian Water Well

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in the town of Kempell, Texas, on the Public square, the sum of seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7500.00) Payments to be made here and after mentioned. Party of the second part agrees to furnish all Machinery, all Pipe, Derrick and any other expense incurred in drilling of the well, and guarantees an Artesian flow of water. It being further understood and agreed that party of the second part shall begin work at once, shall stop at any point where he can develop a good Artesian flow of water and develop the said stratter. The party of the second part is to furnish a four inch gate valve or 4 in inch Pipe and shall attach to casing at which time the well shall be accepted by the parties of the first part. It is further agreed and understood that parties of the first part is to pay to party of the second part \$2000.00 when derrick pipe and Machinery is on the ground \$1000.00 when well is at a depth of 500 feet \$2000.00 when well is 1000 feet deep and the balance when the well is completed.

The State of Texas. Know all men by these presents: That County of Sabine I we, D. Smith as principal and J. O. Toole and J. R. Toole and C. P. Toole as securities, are held and firmly bound unto J. H. McGowan County Judge of Sabine County, Texas, and his successors in office in the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5000.00) for the payment of which well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally, by these presents:

Signed with our hands, and dated this the 28 day of Oct. A. D. 1910. The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas, the above bounden D. Smith was on the 28 day of Oct. 1910 duly employed by contract by the County Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, and the said D. Smith did with said Commissioners Court on the 28 day of Oct. 1910 bind himself

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To bore one certain Artesian well in the town limits of Hemphill Sabine County, Texas, according to the terms and stipulations set out in said contract, made and executed in accordance with law between the said D. A. Smith and said Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, to which contract reference is here made; Now therefore, if the said D. A. Smith shall well and truly perform all the terms and things mentioned in said contract in accordance with said contract, then this obligation shall be void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
