Dawson to repair top coat of floors where loose and pointed and not to exceed 500 square feet, to Calceonire with one coat 2nd story & part of first story not white finished, cleaning up outside base floors and cleaning off yard. To finish up carpenter work as Mr. Browning thinks is necessary to complete contract. Work to begin at once with the understanding that Dawson will have ample time to get in material, balance of furniture not yet delivered to be furnished by Dawson. The Court to receive the house with these exceptions and when these items are completed to pay N. A. Dawson the sum of \$4000.00 as balance due on contract. The house to be occupied by the County but not in such a way as not to interfere with the work.
