J. R. Smith County Judge presiding in the presence of W. R. Hyden County Clerk Sobine, County, Texas, and Jas. G. Barker Justice of the Peace Precinct No 1, Came on to be considered the returns of an election held on the 18th day of March 1911, in the following bounded subdivision to wit: For reference of Bounded Subdivision see Book X Minutes of the Commissioners' Court page 39. To determine whether or not hogs, sheep and goats shall be permitted to run at large within the bounds of said subdivision. And it appearing that said election was in all respects lawfully held and said returns duly and legally made and that were cast at said election 72 votes, of which number 25 votes were cast for "The Stock Law" and 47 votes were cast against "The Stock Law". It is therefore ordered and declared that the proposition to enforce the stock law within the bounds of said subdivision was not sustained by a majority of the free holders voting at said election and that no stock law shall be enforced within the bounds of said subdivision.
