

Agreement to her protest against said name of property, and in appearing to the Board that the same was used to give notice to Lutecher, Stark, Graham, Alvin, James & State and Mylone as to a part of their land owned by said Board. It is therefore now ordered by the Board that the clerk give notice according to law to the above mentioned parties in that portion of their property, notice was served by said clerk and in which they received a notice to meet said Board of Equalization on the 8th day of July, 1911, and show cause, if they can why the decision of the Board as to the name on the said above mentioned property should not be made final. It is ordered that the Board of Equalization stand adjourned until the 1st day of July, 1911.

The great Commission court sitting as a Board of Equalization on the 21st day of May, 1911, passed an order directing the clerk to give written notice according to law to parties whose property was named to meet said Board on the 20th day of June, 1911, to show cause why they should not stand as named on said 20th day of June. The Board of Equalization met according to
