

It is remembered that on this the 23rd day of June A.D., 1911
 the Commissioners Court met in special session, Present

 Court being duly opened by proclamation of the
 sheriff the following proceedings among others were
 had to wit:

It appearing to the Court that there is some unnecessary
 loitering in and through the court house and some
 defacing has been done to the walls, It is therefore by
 the Court that the sheriff keep the court house closed
 up and locked at all times after office hours are over,
 and that all officers in the court house are hereby
 ordered to assist the sheriff in keeping said house
 closed up.

By an act of the Legislature which went into effect on
 June 11th A.D. 1911 which requires the Commissioners Court
 at its first meeting after the above mentioned date, to ap-
 point five County School Trustees of the County Board of Education.

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It is therefore ordered by the court that the following persons be and is hereby appointed who shall constitute the County Board of Education as follows to-wit:
Commissioners Plat No. 1 J. Berryman and ~~John Berryman~~

Whereas on the 20th day of June A.D. 1911 a petition was presented to the court for an election in Sabine County, on the question of authorizing a tax of and at the rate of not exceeding 15 cents on the one hundred dollar valuation of taxable property in said County for the purpose of supplementing the Road and Bridge fund already levied by said court said petition being the requisite number of signatures of property taxpaying voters of said County, and being in every respect in conformity with law.

Now, therefore it is ordered by the court that an election be held on the 5th day of August A.D. 1911 in said Sabine County to determine whether a majority of the legally qualified property taxpaying voters of said County desire to tax themselves for the purpose of supplementing the Road & Bridge fund already levied by the said Court, and to determine whether the commissioners court of this County shall be authorized to levy assess and collect annually a tax of and at the rate of not exceeding 15 cents on the \$100. valuation of taxable property in said County for purpose in addition to the levy already made.

It is further ordered by the court that the managers appointed to hold the General Election is hereby appointed to hold said above mentioned election, and the clerk is authorized to give notice to said managers.

And it is further ordered that the County Judge of this County is hereby directed to issue the necessary proclamation for said election and to have the same published as required by the Constitution and laws of this State.

It is ordered that the court stand adjourned until July 8, 1911
