It is ordered by the Court, that Sabine County cooperate with the United States Department of Agriculture in employing a local agricultural agent for Sabine County, and the sum of Three Hundred and Seventy five (\$375.00) Dollars, is hereby appropriated out of the General County fund for such purpose to be paid in monthly installments of Thirty Seven and 50/100 Dollars (\$37.50), each, and the Clerk is hereby instructed to issue voucher monthly on filing by the United States Agent of copy of his contract with the Federal Government, and monthly statement of services performed.

* Same is effective Sept. 1st 1911, and accounts Oct. 1st 1911, for payment of agents salary for month of Sept.
