Court being duly opened by proclamation of the Sheriff, the following proceedings among others were had to wit:

On this day came on to be considered, the returns of an election, held on the 22nd day of July 1911, in Sabine County Texas. Upon the question for and against amending article 16, section 20 of the Constitution of the State of Texas by striking out and repealing said section and substituting in lieu thereof a new section 20 prohibiting the manufacture for purposes of sale, barter or exchange, and the sale, barter and exchange of intoxicating liquors on and after the second Tuesday in January, A. D. 1912, within this state, except for medicinal, scientific and sacramental purposes. And it appearing that said election was in all respects legally held and that said returns were duly and legally made and that were cast at the various voting precincts of said County 941 votes of which number, 608 were cast in favor of Prohibition and 337 were cast against Prohibition.

On this day came on to be considered a petition asking for a public road leading from Fairmount to History Bluff on Sabine river, said petition bearing the requisite number of signatures, it is hereby
