

Order for Stock Election.

Whereas on the 9th day of October, A.D. 1911, the same being a request term of the Commissioners Court of Sabine County Texas a petition having been filed with the County Clerk of said County, was duly presented signed by

And twenty others, residents of the hereinafter described subdivision of said County, asking for an election to be held in a subdivision of said County bounded as follows:

Beginning at the mouth of the Palogochs creek, thence up said creek to Sarah Hamiltons Mill. Thence with the road by Sarah Hamiltons residence on by McLane Mill to Rock Spring Church to Alie Harris. Thence by Judge Harris old place thence to Peter Kellathys to intersect the Sexton & Milam road. Thence up said road to the cross road near McLanes old shop. Thence with the Carters Ferry road to the Widow Whites. Thence north to the River, thence down the river to the place of beginning. ^{Said above subdivision being the Milam voting precinct No. 4.}

For the purpose of enabling the free holders of said subdivision to determine whether or not hogs sheep and goats shall be permitted to run at large within the bounds of said subdivision

It appearing to the court that said petition was presented in terms of the laws, it is therefore ordered that a special election to be held in said subdivision of said county on Saturday the 2nd day of December A.D. 1911 in Election Precinct no. 4 for the purpose of enabling the holders of said subdivision to determine whether or not hogs, sheep and goats shall be permitted to run at large within the bounds of said subdivision.

At said election all voters who desire to support said proposition shall have printed or written on their ballots the words "For the Stock Law" and those opposing said proposition shall have printed or written on their ballots the words "Against the Stock Law".

And it is further ordered that C. B. Davidson ^{and his heirs} be appointed ^{be appointed} manager of said election for election precinct no. 4.
