

Be it remembered that on this the 27th day of April A. D. 1912 the County Commissioners court in and for Sabine County, Texas, met in Special Session at the Court House in Hemphill, Present and presiding Hon. T. R. Smith County Judge, L. A. Jordan Com. Pre. No. 1, W. J. McDaniel Com. Pre. No. 2, S. H. Hall Com. Pre. No. 3, M. B. Carter Com. Pre. No. 4, Absent. H. J. Solly Sheriff, and W. R. Hyden, Clerk. Court being duly opened by proclamation of the Sheriff the following proceedings among others were had to wit:

It is ordered by the Court that the Delinquent Tax list be published in the Bronson Light for four consecutive weeks.

It is ordered by the Court that the monthly reports of H. J. Solly, Tax Collector, for the months of February, March and April, 1912, be and is hereby approved.

It is ordered by the Court that the Annual Settlement papers of H. J. Solly, Tax Collector, for the taxes of 1911, be and is hereby approved, and that he be allowed credits as shown thereon.

It is ordered by the Court that Martha Drenan be allowed \$15.00 being in destitute condition.

It is ordered by the court that the contract to paint the Courthouse roof, dome and valleys be let to J. C. Speights, for the sum of \$89.90, as per specifications.

It is ordered by the Court that the following change be made on the road leading from Geneva to Bronson said road being in Road Precincts No. 3 & 4, said change beginning about 3-1/2 miles from Bronson and bearing East about 1/2 mile from present road, the whole distance being about 3/4 mile.

Court was ordered adjourned until the next regular term.
