It is further ordered that he file suit against J. H. McGown ex-County Judge for the sum of \$30.00 paid by the party hiring Claud Burns County Convict, to J. H. McGown but which has not been paid over to the County Treasurer. The County Attorney is instructed to file suit also against the Bondsmen of the said J. H. McGown.

It is ordered by the court that the court stand adjourned until May 27, 1912.
