It is ordered by the court that the Clerk issue to L. P. McFarling warrant for \$15.00 for his services rendered in looking after and administering to the wants of W. F. Glover who being in destitute conditions.

It is ordered by the Court that the Clerk issue to Biggie Thomas warrant for \$7.50 for administering to the wants and necessities of Rust Burroughs, colored, who was in destitute conditions.

It is ordered by the Court that the Quarterly Statement of W. R. Hyden County Clerk be and is hereby approved.

It is ordered that the Court stand adjourned until the next regular term.
