Court being duly opened by proclamation of the Sheriff the following proceedings among others were had to wit:

It is ordered by the Court that the Clerk issue warrants in favor of L. P. McFarland for \$15.00 for looking after and administering to the needs of W. F. Glover, who being in destitute circumstances.

It is ordered by the Court that the Clerk warrant in favor of Biggie Thomas for \$7.50 for administering to the wants of Rush Burrough during his sickness, said Burrough being helpless and in destitute circumstances.

It is ordered by the Court that the Pension application of Mrs. Fannie Bell, Mrs Elizabeth Carlton and Mrs. Harret Galwell presented to said Court by Hon. T. R. Smith County Judge, be and the same is hereby approved.

It is ordered by the Court that the Trustees of Hemphill Common School District No. 1 are hereby authorized to sell the old School building in the town of Hemphill at public sale for cash, said proceeds be placed to the credit of said Common School district No. 1.

It is ordered by the Court U. Humphreys be allowed \$15.00 he being in destitute circumstances.

It is ordered by the Court that the order passed on 8 day of 4/19/12 reducing the hire of County Convicts from \$12.50 to \$8.00 be and the same is now rescinded and the County Judge is authorized to hire all convicts for the sum of \$12.50 per month.

It is ordered that the Clerk issue to the members of the Court their per diem for 4 days services.

It is ordered that the Court stand adjourned until its next regular term.
