Smith County Judge, L. A. Jordan Com. Prec. No. 1, W. J. McDaniel Com. Prec. No. 2, S. H. Hall Com. Prec. No. 3, M. B. Carter Com. Prec. No. 4, H. J. Solly Sheriff and W. R. Hyden Clerk. Court being duly opened by proclamation of the Sheriff the following proceedings among others were had to-wit:

It is ordered by the court that the resignation of G. B. Furgerson as Constable of Precinct No. 6, be and the same is hereby accepted.

It is ordered by the Court that L. G. Fetner be and is hereby appointed Constable of Precinct No. 6.

It is ordered by the Court that the that the Official Bond of L. G. Fetner Constable of Precinct No. 6, be and the same is hereby approved.

It is ordered by the Court that the Tabular Statement of W. R. Hyden County Clerk for quarter ending Aug. 1912 be and the same is hereby approved.

It is ordered by the Court that the Clerk issue to the members of the Court their per diem for one days service.

Road

It is ordered by the Court a Second Class be established in Sabine County having its points of beginning and termination as follows: Beginning at the County line about two miles West of Bronson, and ending at Bronson in Precinct No. 3, the whole distance being about 2 miles;

It is ordered by the court that the Court stand adjourned until the next regular term.
