Present and presiding Hon. T. R. Smith, County Judge, L. A. Jordan Com. Prec. No. 1, W. J. McDaniel Com. Prec. No. 2, S. H. Hall, Com. Prec. No. 3, M. B. Carter Com. Prec. No. 4. H. J. Solly Sheriff and W. R. Hyden Clerk. Court being duly opened by proclamation of the Sheriff the following proceedings among others were had to wit:

It is ordered by the Court that the Clerk issue warrants to the managers of the General Election held on Nov. 5, 1912 to the amount of \$4.00 and to the Presiding officers \$6.00

It is ordered by the Court that the Quarterly Reports of all the County and Precinct officers for the Quarter ending Nov. 11, 1912 be and the same is hereby approved.

It is ordered by the Court that the Clerk issue to the Salaried officers their salary for the Quarter ending Nov. 11, 1912.

It is ordered by the Court that the Clerk issue to the members of the Court their per diem for three days services.

It is ordered by the Court that the Clerk issue to Mrs. Nellie Low warrant for \$15.00 on account of being in indigent condition.

REPORT OF JURY OF VIEW

TO the Hon. Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, The undersigned jurors, acting under the order of this court made on the 12 day of Aug. A. D. 1912, and after being duly sworn, did, on the 26 day of Sept. 1912, proceed to lay out and survey a crossing on the Santa Fe Ry; Beginning at Bailey street where said street crosses the South line of said Santa Fe Railroad right-of-way, Thence North to the North line of said right-of-way being a distance of 200 ft. All of said road being in the town of Bronson, Texas, and at the same time proceeded to assess the damages incidental to the opening of said road, after having given notice in writing to the land owners through whose land said street runs, said notice and the return of service thereof being herewith returned as a part of this report.

The field notes of said survey and description of said streets are as follows: On the west side of said Santa Fe Ry to Block 28 & 29 of the Santa Fe Townsite Co. Survey. Thence and to Blocks 90 & 107 on East side, of Santa Fe Ry, owners of land through which said road runs having presented to us attachment of the damages claimed by them respectfully, which are returned with this report, we assess their damages as follows no damages claimed.
