Whereas, on the 20th day of January 1913, a petition was presented to the commissioner's Court of Sabine County for an election in common school District No. 3, in said County, on the question of authorizing a ~~tax~~ tax of and at the rate of 40 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of taxable property in said District for the purpose of supplementing the State School Funds apportioned to said District said petition bearing the requisite numbers of signatures of tax paying voters of said district and being in every way in conformity with law; and it further appearing that by virtue of an election held in said District heretofore, to wit; more than two years next before the filing of the above mentioned petition, and that in said election a majority of the legally qualified property tax paying voters in said district voted upon themselves a special tax of 20 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of taxable property in said district for the purpose of supplementing the State School funds apportioned to said District, and it further appearing that said special tax, as heretofore voted in said District, is still in force and effect in said district by virtue of said election; Now therefore I, J.B. Lewis in my capacity as county judge of Sabine County, Texas, do hereby order that an election be held in and for said common school district No. 3, of said Sabine County, Texas, on the 31st day of May 1913, at the school house in said common school district No. 3, as established by order of the Commissioner's court of this County of date of the 24th day of September, 1906, which said order is recorded in Vol. "I" page 434 of the minutes of said Commissioner's court, to determine whether or not the majority of the legally qualified property tax paying voters of said district desire to increase the special school tax in said district from 20 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of taxable property in said district to 40 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of taxable property in said district and to determine whether the commissioner's court of said County shall be authorized to levy, assess and collect annually a tax of and at the rate of 40 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of taxable property in said district for that purpose of supplementing the State School Funds apportioned to said district.

S.M. Tinsley is hereby appointed presiding officer for said election and he shall select two judges and two clerks to assist him in holding said election, and he shall within five days after said election has been held, make due return thereof, to the Commissioner's court of said county, as is required by law for holding general elections.

The ballots for said election shall have written or printed thereon the following:

"FOR INCREASE OF SCHOOL TAX"

"AGAINST INCREASE OF SCHOOL TAX".

All persons who are legally qualified voters of this state and of this County and who are resident property tax payers in said district shall be entitled to vote in said election.

The sheriff of Sabine County shall give due notice of said election by posting three notices at three public places in said district for three weeks before the election.
