

On this the 9th. day of June A.D. 1913, at a regular term of the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, ~~it was ordered by the~~ it was ordered by the Court that the boundaries of Milam Common School District No. 32 be changed so as to include and conform to the following notes and bounds, to-wit:-

Beginning at the S.W. corner of the Moses Hill survey on the North bank of Polegeche creek, thence down said Polegeche creek with its meanders to the S.W. corner of a subdivision of One hundred acres in said Hill survey for John S. Goodrich, thence Northerly with the West boundary line of said Goodrich one hundred to the S.W. cor. of a subdivision of one hundred acres in said Hill survey for John Nichols, thence Northerly with said Nichols West boundary line to his N.W. corner on the North Boundary line of said Moses Hill survey. Thence Southeasterly with the North boundary line of said Hill survey to the South West corner of the C.M. Jackson survey, thence northerly with said Jackson West boundary line to the N.W. corner of said Jackson survey, same being the South West corner of T. & N. Ry. Co. Sect. No. 17, thence Northerly with the West boundary line of said Sect. No. 17 to its north west corner on the South boundary line of the John B. Gaines survey, thence S. 81 E. with the South boundary line of said Gaines survey to its South East corner, thence N. 9 E. with the East boundary line of said Gaines survey to its N.E. corner on the South boundary line of the James Gaines league, thence North

81 W. with the South boundary line of said James Gaines league and the N. boundary line of the John B. Gaines survey to the N.W. corner of said John B. Gaines survey continuing same course on the S.W. cor. of said James Gaines league, thence North 9 E. with the West boundary line of said James Gaines league to the N.E. corner of the W.B. Frazier survey, thence Southwesterly with the North B. line of said Frazier and the S.B. line of James Mason league passing W.B. Frazier's N.W. corner and then with the N.B. line of the John S. Chiverval and the South boundary line of said Mason to the N.W. corner of said Chiverval same being the N.E. corner of the Isaac Powell, thence West with the N.B. line of said Powell league to the N.E. corner of a subdivision originally surveyed for Alexander Harris, thence South 25 E. to the E. boundary line of said Alexander Harris subdivision to its S.E. corner, the N.E. corner of land now owned by W.H. Cooper, thence South with the East boundary line of said W.H. Cooper land to his corner on Tanyard branch, (Wilson's Tanyard branch) thence Southwesterly with the said Tanyard branch same being the South boundary line of the said W.H. Coopers land to Sulphur creek, thence on the South boundary lines of said W.H. Cooper land crossing the North boundary line of J. Smith to his S.W. corner on the East boundary line of the W.W. Halbert 636 acre subdivision on the John Smith survey, thence North 15 W. with the East line of said Halbert 636 acre subdivision to the S.W. corner of Isaac Powell league to the North boundary line on the said J. Smith survey same being the S.E. corner of the A.H. McGown survey, thence West with the North boundary line of said J. Smith survey on the South boundary line of the A.H. McGown survey to the N.W. corner of the said 636 acre subdivision in the name of W.W. Halbert, thence S. 15 E. with the West line of said W.W. Halbert 636 acre, the East line of land owned by L.T. Halbert to the S.W. corner of said 636 acre subdivision on the upper Milam and San Augustine road, thence Westerly with said road to the N.W. corner of the subdivision of 50 acres owned by Joel Halbert, thence Southerly with West line of said 50 acres to its S.W. corner on the lower Milam and San Augustine road, thence Easterly with said road to the West boundary line of land owned by L.T. Halbert, thence Southerly with the West line of said L.T. Halbert's land to the S. boundary line of the John Smith survey, thence South 70 E. to the N.E. corner of the Ira McDaniel survey same being ~~the~~ a corner of the Isaac Carrodine survey, thence Southeasterly with ~~the~~ said Smith and Carrodine lines to another corner of said Smith and Carrodine survey, thence Northeasterly with said Smith and Carrodine lines to where Baragous creek crosses said line, thence Southeasterly with said creek to where said creek empties into Polegocho creek, thence down said creek with its meanders to the place of beginning.

County Judge of Sabine County, Texas: We the undersigned qualified property tax paying voters of Common School District No. 22 in Sabine County, Texas, desiring to tax ourselves for the purpose of supplementing the State school fund apportioned to said School District, hereby make application to the County Judge of Sabine County, Texas, for an order for an election to be held in said Common School District No. 22 in said County, to determine whether or not a tax of and at the rate of .40 cents on the one hundred dollars valuation of taxable property in said District shall be levied for said purpose.

County of Sabine. | Whereas on the 4th. day of June 1913 a petition was presented to me for an election in Common School District No. 22 in said County on the question of authorizing a tax of and at the rate of .40 cents on the one hundred dollars valuation of taxable property in said District for the purpose of supplementing the State school funds apportioned to said district, said petition being in every way in conformity with the law: Now therefore, I J.B. Lewis, in my capacity as County Judge of said Sabine County, Texas, do hereby order that an election be held in and for said school district in said County and State, on the 12th. day of July 1913, at the school house in said District, the same being the building now used for the purpose of teaching school in said district, said district being created by order of the Commissioners Court of the County on the 24th. day of Sept. 1906 which said order is recorded in Book I page 440 of the minutes of said Court, to determine whether or not a majority of the legally qualified property tax paying voters of said Common School District No. 22 of said Sabine County, Texas, desire to tax themselves for the purpose of supplementing the state school funds apportioned to said district and to determine whether or not the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, shall be authorized to levy, assess and collect annually a tax of and at the rate of .40 cents on the one hundred dollars valuation of taxable property in said Common school district No. 22 in said Sabine County, Texas, for the purpose of supplementing the State School funds apportioned to said Common school district.

W. L. Fussell is hereby appointed presiding officer of said election, and he shall select two judges and two clerks to assist him in holding said election, and he shall make due return of said election to commissioners Court of said County within five days after said election has been held, as is required by law for holding general elections.

The ballots for said election shall have written or printed thereon the following:  
"For the School Tax."  
"Against the School Tax."

All persons who are legally qualified voters of this state and of this County and who are resident property tax payers in said district are entitled to vote in said election.

The sheriff of Sabine County, Texas, shall give due notice of said election by posting three notices at three public places in said district for three weeks before said election.
