

The State of Texas,
County of Sabine.

Whereas, on the 12th. day of May 1913, a petition was presented to the Hon. Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, for an election in Common school district No. 36 on this County on the question of authorizing a tax of and at the rate of .50 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of taxable property in said District for the purpose of supplementing the State School fund apportioned to said district, said petition bearing the requisite number of signatures of property tax paying voters of said district, and being in every respect in conformity with law; and it appearing that heretofore to wit: more than two years before petition, there was voted in said District, a maintenance school tax of .20 on the \$100.00 valuation of taxable property in said district, and it further appearing that said special maintenance school tax of .20 on the one hundred dollars valuation of taxable property in said district is still in force and effect and has not heretofore been revoked by any vote of the legally qualified property tax paying voters of said district, and it appearing that said petition was for the increase of said tax from 20 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of taxable property in said district to .50 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of the taxable property in said district, for the purpose of supplementing the state school fund apportioned to said district, and said petition having been duly presented to the said Hon. Commissioners Court and having been granted by the Court and the Court having ordered and directed that an election be held in said district in accordance with the prayer contained in said petition:-

Now therefore, I, J.B. Lewis, in my capacity as County Judge of Sabine County Texas, do hereby order that an election be held on the 12th. day of July 1913, at the residence of W.E. Smith in said Common School district No. 36 of this County as established by order of the Commissioners Court of this County of date the 10th. day of February 1913, which said order is recorded in Book I page 57 of the minutes of said commissioners Court to determine whether or not a majority of the legally qualified property tax paying voters of said district desire to tax themselves 50 cents on the one hundred dollars valuation of taxable property in said district for the purpose of supplementing the state school funds apportioned to said district and to determine whether the Commissioners Court of said County shall be authorized to levy, assess and collect annually a tax of and at the rate of .50 cents on the one hundred dollars valuation of taxable property in said district for said purpose.

W.T. Pulliam is hereby appointed presiding officer of said election, and he shall within five days after said election has been held, make due return thereof to the Commissioners Court of this County as required by law for holding general elections.

The Ballots for said election shall written or printed thereon the following:

"For increase of school tax".

"Against increase of school tax".

All persons who are legally qualified voters of this state and of this County and who are resident property tax payers in said school district shall be entitled to vote in said election.

The Sheriff of Sabine County shall give due notice of said election by posting three notices at three public places in said district for three weeks before said election is held.
