

Hemphill, Texas, Aug 11th, 1913.

Commissioners Court met in regular Quarterly meeting August the 11th, 1913 with Hon. J.B. Lewis, presiding, Geo. Nerren, W.J. McDaniel, S.H. Hall and A.T. Mathews, Commissioners, H.J. Solly, Sheriff and F.P. Adams, County Clerk.

It is ordered by the Court that J.M. Payne be exempt from Public Road duty on account of not being able to perform manual labor.

It is ordered by the Court that Warner Conner be exempt from Public Road duty on account not being able to perform manual labor.

H. J. Solly is hereby authorized to have and keep the Court house square cleaned and to purchase a grass mower for the County.

G. W. Nerren is hereby authorized to have trough made at the County Well for watering stock and to have the gates fixed with latches so that they can be kept shut.

It appearing to the Court that the Ross Spring School District No. 20 as bounded at present is not for the best interest of the schools located therein and that it would be more practicable to make a change therein and for the best interest of the schools therein it is therefore ordered by the Court that said District be changed and that the boundaries of the said Ross Spring School District as fixed by the Commissioners Court on the 24th day of Sept. 1906, be changed and that said District be and is hereafter described as follows:

Beginning at the North East corner of the John Craughon survey on the West bank of Sabine river. Thence Westerly with Craughons north line to his north west corner. Thence south west with Craughons west line to the north line of the Richard Slaughter league. Thence south east with Slaughters north line to his north east corner. Thence south west with Slaughters league line to the north west corner of the R. Slaughter survey. Thence South east with R. Slaughters north line to his N.E. corner. Thence South west with R. Slaughters east line to the Patroon Bayou. Thence up Patroon Bayou to Richard Slaughters east league line. Thence south east with Richard Slaughters E. league line to the Theo Harris survey. Thence north west with Theo Harris north line to the Wm. Defee. Thence south west with Wm. Defees east line to David Huffmans north east corner. Thence south east and south with D. Huffmans east line to the Isaac Powell survey. Thence East along Isaac Powell's north line to the James Mason south league line. Thence north east with south line of the Jas. Mason league to the West boundary line of the James Gaines league. Thence Southerly with Jas. Gaines west league line to his S.W. corner. Thence easterly with Jas. Gaines South boundary line to the Sabine River. Thence up the Sabine River to the place of beginning.

J. M. Griffin was appointed overseer of the Milam and Tebo road by the Court.

The Court ordered that the ~~6600~~ Hemphill Pineland and Brockeland road South of Pineland be changed as follows:- To run the West line of Santa Fe right of way to M.E. Coopers north line, thence westerly on his north line to his N.W. corner, thence southerly with Coopers west line to the N.E. corner of a 3 1/2 acre tract owned by Jas. A. McElroy, thence westerly with McElroys north line to his N.W. corner, thence South with J.A. McElroys west line to his S.W. corner, thence easterly with J.A. McElroys South line to his S.E. corner, thence southerly with the West line of Mrs. A. McElroys tract to where it will intersect the old Pineland and Brockeland road.

Lutcher Stark and Brown proposed to pay ~~6349~~ \$2300.00 in settlement of their 1911 delinquent tax and \$1800.00 in settlement of their 1912 delinquent tax and vote being taken, Geo. Nerren, W.J. McDaniel and S.H. Hall voted that settlement be made on the proposed basis and A.T. Mathews voted against it. It was ordered by the Court that

This is advised by the County Clerk - changing the map by changing the boundaries and putting in the new boundaries as the old map of the land owners.

settlement be made as per the proposed settlement.

The Court allowed L.S. Bell to put 10 foot gates on the old Brookeland and San Augustine road where road passes through the land of L.S. Bell with sufficient styles.


The Court ordered that a door be cut in the water tank frame and a door be made for it with lock and key and that the County wood be kept in it.

It is ordered by the Court that the County Treasurer be instructed to transfer \$250.00 from the Jury Fund to the Road and Bridge Fund.

The Court allowed Mrs. Nellie Low \$10.00 and Mrs. Meeks \$5.00 as a county pension.

The Court instructed the Clerk to issue each officer his salary for the past quarter and to issue each officer of the court his per diem.

The Court adjourned to meet at next regular meeting.
