

Commissioners Court met in regular monthly meeting December the 8th. 1913
with the following present- J.B. Lewis County Judge, presiding, Geo. W. Herran,
Commissioner, W.J. McDaniel Commissioner, S.H. Hall, Commissioner, A.T. Mathews,
Commissioner, H.J. Solly, Sheriff and F.P. Adams, Clerk.

Court was called to order by proclamation of the Sheriff.

Accounts were allowed as per accounts allowed ledger.

The Court authorized A.M. Huffman County Attorney, to file suit to collect

The petition was signed by the required number of legally qualified voters
of Prec. No. 3 Sabine County, Texas and the Court having considered said petition
ordered that an election be held in voting Prec. No. 3 of Sabine County, Texas,
to determine whether or not Pool Rooms shall be prohibited in said voting Prec.
No. 3, Sabine County, Texas; and said election was ordered to be held on December
27th. 1913 in the Public School building at Brookeland, Texas, in said voting
Prec. No. 3 and the said election to be held by the regular election officers
for said voting precinct.

It appearing to the court that a tract of land belonging to Mrs. S.E. Lay-
field in Sabine County on the Jas. Gaines survey was placed on the unrendered
rolls for 1913 and valued on said rolls at \$10.00 per acre and it appearing that
said lands should be rendered at \$3.00 per acre, it is ordered by the Court that
the taxes for 1913 on said tract of land be and the same is hereby reduced to
\$3.00 per acre on said lands and the tax collector of Sabine County is hereby
authorized to accept and collect said taxes on a basis of \$3.00 per acre and
receipt for same in full payment of all taxes on said lands for 1913.


It appearing to the Court that a tract of 80 acres of land on the D. Refro
headright belonging to E.N. Beall was valued at \$10.00 per acre and whereas it
should have been valued at \$3.00 per acre is hereby ordered that the Tax Collector
is authorized to collect the tax on said tract of land at the rate of \$3.00 per
acre for the year 1913.

The Court allowed M.H. Rollins a County Pension of \$15.00 on account of be unable to work and in indigent circumstances.

There being no further business the Court adjourned to meet at the next regular meeting, after instructing the Clerk to issue each officer his per diem.
