It is ordered by the Court that consent, permission and authority be and is hereby given and granted unto W.H. Butler and R.H. Minton, trustees, their successors and assigns to locate, build, construct, maintain and operate a system of telephone lines in and upon and along all of the public roads and public streets of Sabine County, Texas with the right to erect poles and string lines of wire along said public roads and public streets for the purpose of conveying telephone messages from one point to another in said Sabine County, Texas and elsewhere and to construct, maintain and use all mechanical appliances and contrivencies necessary and suitable to operate the same. The poles erected by said trustees, their successors and assigns, along the said public roads and public streets, in Sabine County, Texas, shall be so placed as to not interfere with the traffic over and along said public roads and public streets and the wires where same shall cross said public roads and public streets shall be placed at such a height above said roads and streets as to not to interfere with the use of said public roads and streets by the traveling public.

In constructing, repairing and operating said telephone lines or system, said trustees, their successors and assigns, shall use every reasonable and proper precaution to avoid damages to persons or property.

It is the order of the Court that three Phones be put in the Court house, one at the Clerks office, one at Sheriffs office and one in the Co. Judges office as soon as the Sabine Citizens Telephone Company is organized in put in operation.

The petition of J.T. Fuller and J.D. Edgar to be allowed to join in the Stock Law territory in Prec. No. 3 was granted.

Court ordered the clerk to issue each officer his per diem.

There being no further business Court adjourned to meet at next regular meeting.
