

Commissioners Court met in Quarterly session August the 10th. 1914 with the following members present:-

Hon. J.B.Lewis, Judge Presiding, Geo. W. Nerren, Com. Prec. No. 1, W.J. McDaniel, Com. Prec. No. 2, S.H. Hall, Com. Prec. No. 3 and A.T. Mathews, Com. Prec. No. 4. H.J.Solly, Sheriff and F.P.Adams, Clerk.

Court was opened by proclamation of the sheriff.

The following matters together with others were had to wit:-

The resignation of Jas. G. Barker as Justice of the Peace of Prec. No. 1 came on to be considered and it was ordered by the Court that the resignation be accepted.

The application of H.E. White to be appointed Justice of the Peace of Prec. No. 1 came on to be considered and it was ordered that H.E. White be appointed Justice of the Peace of Prec. No. 1 and that his bond be approved.

Accounts were allowed as per accounts allowed ledger.

The order made at last meeting creating the Six Mile School Dist. No. 39 is hereby rescinded and to be of no force or effect.

The petition for Bond election in School Dist. No. 10 came before the Court to be considered and after due deliberation it was ordered that no attention be paid to the petition and upon motion the petition was withdrawn.

The Court ordered that J.A.Partin be given a contract to get and deliver to the County on the Court house square 30 cords of Heater wood at \$3.50 per cord and Geo. W. Nerren was ordered to check the wood in the woods.

The Court ordered the Clerk to issue warrant to L.A.Jordan for \$28.12 out of the General County Fund for witness fees in the case First National Bank Vs. Sabine County and J.O.Toole.

The Court ordered the Clerk to issue warrant to J.A.Scurlock for \$25.68 out of the General County Fund for witness fees in case First National Bank Vs. Sabine County and J.O.Toole.

The Court ordered the County Attorney to bring suit for collection on the following convict bonds-

The petition for change in Public road as per the following was granted by the Court-

The Court ordered that a voting Precinct be established and known as Voting Precinct No. 13 Bounded as follows-

Beginning at the northeast corner of the Henry Canfield league, on west bank of Sabine river. Thence westerly with the north line of said league to the southwest corner of the E.M. Carlton Survey of 640 acres. Thence Northerly to the northeast corner of said Carlton Survey. Thence westerly to Southwest corner of J.S. Shiveral Survey. Thence Northerly to northwest corner of said Chiveral Survey. Thence westerly to south-west corner of the G.L. Bourland League. Thence Southerly to the Southwest Corner of the Robert Russell Survey. Thence westerly to the Southwest corner of said Russell Survey. Thence Northerly to said Russell's Corner on South line of Eli Low, League. Thence westerly on South line of said Low League to the Southwest corner of the D. T. Richardson 1340, acre Survey on said League. Thence northerly to northwest corner of said 1340 acres. Thence easterly with north line of said Low, League to the most southern corner of the Jesse Low League. Thence westerly to South-west corner of said Jesse Low Survey. Thence Northerly to said Jesse Lows Northwest Corner. Thence easterly to the Northwest corner of said Jesse Lows Survey. Thence Southerly to Northwest corner of said G.L. Bourland League. Thence easterly with north line of said Bourland League to its Northwest corner on west bank of Sabine river. Thence down said river to the beginning.

The returns of a School Tax Election held in Plainview School Dist. No. 31 came on to be considered and the following result was found-

For Increase of School Tax-----10 votes.

Against Increase of School Tax----- 1 Vote.

The Court ordered that the tax be levied, assessed and collected for the year 1914.

The Court ordered that the following tax rate be placed on the One hundred dollars valuation for the year 1914-

General County Fund-----	.25¢ on the \$100.00 valuation.
R Road and Bridge Fund-----	.15¢ on the \$100.00 "
Jury Fund-----	.15¢ on the \$100.00 "
Court House Bond Fund-----	.10¢ on the \$100.00 "

The Court allowed Mrs. Mary Ann Meeks \$5.00 for County Pension.

The Court allowed Henry Thomas ~~\$20.00~~ \$10.00 for County Pension to be issued to J.S.Goodrich.

The Court Allowed Mrs. Ferrel \$15.00 for County Pension to be issued to Gill Ferrel.

The Court allowed Mrs. Julia G.Coussons \$20.00 for Assessors Abstract Book.

The Court ordered the Clerk to cancel Warrant No. 2080 in favor of W.R.Smith for \$20.00.

The Court ordered that the County Judge be allowed to accept Road and Bridge Script on all convict bonds due the County.

The returns of Special election held in Common School Dist. No. 35 for increase of school tax came on to be considered and it was ordered that the ~~6000000~~ Tax be levied, assessed and collected as per the result of the County.

The Court ordered the clerk to issue each officer his past quarters salary.

The matter of employing an agricultural agent for the ensuing year came on to be considered and the Court having considered the application of D.O.Price for the position the court took a vote and on count it was found that Geo. W. Newnan, W.J.McDaniel and S.H.Hall voted that the Court employ D.O.Price and A.T.Mathews voted not to employ him or any one, it is therefore ordered by the Court that D.O.Price be employed as Agricultural Agent for the next year, the salary to be fixed at the next meeting of the Commissioners Court.
