J.B.Lewis, Judge Presiding, Geo. W. Narren Com. Prec. No. 1, W.J.McDaniel, Com. Prec. No. 2, S. H. Hall, Com. Prec. No. 3, and A.T.Mathews, Com. Prec. No. 4, H.J. Solly, Sheriff and F.P.Adams, Clerk.

The Court was opened by proclamation of the Sheriff.

The following matters together with others were had to wit:-

A petition from Curry Hill School Dist. No. 26 to increase the maintenance from .20 cents to .35 cents was presented to the Court and said petition was granted and the Election ordered to be held on Saturday December the 5th. 1914.

The Court allowed N.W. Williams \$4.00 for ten gallons of paint and instructed the clerk to issue him warrant for the contract of painting the Court House roof.

Moved and seconded that the County Judge Salary be raised \$300.00 per annum to take effect for current quarter ending 2nd. Monday in November 1914. Upon vote S.H. Hall, W. J. McDaniel and G.W. Narren voted in favor of the measure and A.T. Mathews voted against it.

The Clerk is ordered to issue warrant out of Road and Bridge fund for the following amounts on account of the original having been lost-

T.C. Speights-----\$100.00

J.H. Smith----- 20.00

J.H. Smith----- 1.50

The Court allowed H.J. Solly, Tax Collector \$10.00 for Stamps.

H. L. McDaniel is appointed Presiding Officer of voting Precinct No. 13.

Accounts were allowed as per accounts Allowed Ledger.

There being no further business the Court ordered the Clerk to issue each officer his per diem.

Court adjourned to meet at next meeting.

Upon motion the Court accepted the Judgement as rendered in the District Court in the Tax Suit, Lucher, Stark and Brown for the years 1911 and 1912.


