

Commissioners Court met in quarterly meeting November the 9th. 1914 with the following members present: Hon. J.B. Lewis, County Judge, Presiding, Geo. W. Herren Com. Prec. No. 1, W.J. McDaniel Com. Prec. No. 2, S.H. Hall Com. Prec. No. 3 and A.T. Mathews Com. Prec. No. 4, H.J. Solly Sheriff and F.P. Adams County Clerk.

The Court was opened by proclamation of the Sheriff.

The following matters together with others were had to wit:

Accounts were allowed as per accounts allowed ledger.

The returns of the General Election held Nov. the 3rd. 1914 came on to be counted the Record of Elections on file in the Clerks office show the officers that were elected as per the Court.

The Court ordered that all election officers be paid the amount of \$2.00 each for holding the election and the returning officer be paid \$8.00.

The Court allowed each officer his salary for the past quarter.

The Court recessed until November the 13th 1914 on account of Mr. Mathews having been called to the bedside of his father-in-law.

The Court met on the 13th. with all officers present as of the 9th.

The Court ordered that the following change be made in the Milam and Geneva road—Beginning at Will Paynes place thence with J.L. Masons N.E. line until it reaches C.H. Cordrays line thence West on the divisional line of C.H. Cordray and J.L. Mason to the S.W. corner of C.H. Cordrays place; thence North on the line of C.H. Cordray and Mrs. Sallie Cellatley to a point just North of C.H. Cordrays house; thence by Mrs. Cellatleys place to where it intersects the old road.

The Court ordered that the valuation on 98 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres of land on the J.S. Lane survey belonging to S.S. Eddings be reduced from \$6.00 per acre to \$4.00 per acre.

The County Officers quarterly reports were approved.

The Court ordered the Clerk to issue a warrant for \$2.25 to Geo. Clark being the amount overpaid on fine and convict bond.

It is ordered by the Court that road leading from the Dug Out on the Geneva and San Augustine road to Will Jones place be discontinued on account of the protest of W.A. Maxey.

The Court ordered that the Pineland and Bronson road be straightened from a point where the road enters the John Gilbert tract of land on South line to near the Plainview School house according to survey made by the owners of the Gilbert tract of land.


The Court ordered that the Yellow Pine and Bronson road be changed to begin at the West line of the A.J. Lott 141 acre tract thence to Plainview school house to intersect Pineland and Bronson road 375 yards South of said School house.

The Court ordered that the old Homer and Hemphill road be changed leading from Plainview School house through the John Gilbert tract of land so that it will straighten said road to A.H. McGowns place.

The Court ordered that the road leading from Jim Stricklands place to the Plainview school house be discontinued.

Court ordered the clerk to issue each officer his per diem.

The Court adjourned to meet at next regular meeting.
