

The Commissioners Court met in regular monthly meeting December the 14th, 1914, with the following officers present:- J.B. Lewis County Judge, Geo. W. Neffen Com. Prec. No. 1, J.A. Hyden Com. Prec. No. 2, L.T. Halbert Com. Prec. No. 3, and C.M. Bennett Com. Prec. No. 4, James G. Barker Sheriff and T.P. Adams Clerk.

The Court was opened by proclamation of the Sheriff.

The following matters together with others came on to be heard and considered.

A petition having been presented to the Court on October the 12th, 1914 from the patrons of Common School District No. 26 known as Curry Hill School District and which petition was for the purpose of increasing the School tax from .20 cents on the \$100.00 to .35 cents on the \$100.00 valuation the same was granted at that time and an election ordered to be held December the 5th, 1914 but for some reason same was not held and the following order is this day made:

The State of Texas, :

County of Sabine, : Whereas on the 14th, day of December A.D. 1914, a petition was presented to the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, for an election in Common School District No. 26 of this County on the question of authorizing a tax of and at the rate of .35 cents on the hundred dollars valuation of taxable property in said District for the purpose of supplementing the State School fund apportioned to said District, said petition bearing the requisite number of signatures of property tax paying voters of said district and being in every way in conformity with law. Now therefore, I, J.B. Lewis County Judge of Sabine County, Texas, in my capacity as County Judge of said County, do hereby order that an election be held on the 16th, day of January 1915 at the school house in said School District No. 26, of this County as established by order of the Commissioners Court of said County of date the 9th, day of February 1909, which said order is recorded in book J pages 166 and 167 of the minutes of said Commissioners Court to determine whether or not a majority of the legally qualified property tax paying voters of said Common School District desire to increase the maintenance tax in said School District from .20 cents on the one hundred dollars taxable property in said district to .35 cents on the one hundred dollars of taxable property in said district for the purpose of supplementing the State School fund apportioned to said district and to determine whether or not the Commissioners Court of said County shall be authorized to levy, assess and collect annually a tax of and at the rate of .35 cents on the one hundred dollars valuation of taxable property in said district for said purpose.

H.L. Williams is hereby appointed presiding officer of said election and he shall elect two judges and two clerks to assist him in holding the same, and he shall within five days after said election has been held make due return thereof to the Commissioners Court of this County, as is required by law for holding a general election.

The ballots for said election shall have written or printed thereon the following:

"For Increase of School Tax".

"Against Increase of School Tax".

All persons who are legally qualified voters of this state and this County and who are resident property tax payers in said district shall be entitled to vote in said election.

The Sheriff of this County shall give notice of this election by posting three notices at three different public places in said District for three weeks before said election.

County of San Augustine To the Commissioners Court of San Augustine County  
Commissioners Texas.

Whereas at the February term of the Commissioners Court an order was passed that, the boundary line between San Augustine and Sabine Counties should be run by Jas. A. McLeuren, County Surveyor of San Augustine County. Beginning at the N.E. Cor. of San Augustine Co. and continuing South as far as the two counties adjoin. The order says that the work of locating said boundary line shall begin on the 27th day of May 1912. But suit the convenience of the Sabine County Surveyor and by verbal consent of the Court, the time was postponed until June 19th, 1912. On the 19th day of June 1912, I met the surveyor from Sabine County, Mr. J.C. Barker at the N.E. cor. of San Augustine County, the point designated to begin to work, and from that point we proceeded to run said line just as it is given in the field notes of San Augustine County, as given in Batt's Civil Statutes of Texas, in Vol. 1, page 47. We measured the line carefully and set rich pine post at the ends of each mile and at the corners. The posts were 5 feet long and not less than 8 in diameter. We set the posts 3 ft. in the ground and raised a mound of earth around each post.

We herewith attach the field notes of said boundary and make them a part of this report.

Beginning at the N.E. Cor. of San Augustine County, it being the N.W. Cor. of Sabine County and South Cor. of Shelby County a post was set and mound of earth raised. This cor. is S. 17-1/4 E. 71-1/2 yrs. from the N.W. Cor. of the Wm. Smith Survey on Z. Turner's S.B. line, a sweet gum 36 in. in diameter marked C.N.C. brs. S. 104 E. 71-1/2 yrs. a hickory.

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16 in. in diameter marked C.L.C. brs. S. 29-1/4° W. 5-1/5 yrs. an Elm 12 in. in diameter brs. N. 56-3/4° E. 11-2/5 yrs. Thence due South at 171 yrs. a branch at 271 yrs. the middle of clear Beech creek 12 yrs. wide, course, N.E. at 451 yrs. a branch, course N.E. at 790 yrs. crossed S.B. line of the Wm. S. Smith Survey, at a point N. 73° E. 420 yrs. from the S.W.
