

Commissioners Court of Sabine County met in regular quarterly session Monday May the 10th. 1915 with the following members present - J.B. Lewis, County Judge, Geo. W. Nerren Com. Free. No. 1, J.A. Hyden Com. Free. No. 2, L.T. Helbert, Com. Free. No. 3 and C.M. Bennett Com. Free. No. 4, R.P. Adams, Clerk and Jas. G. Barker, Sheriff.

Court was opened by proclamation of the sheriff.

The following matters together with others were had to wit:-

Accounts were allowed as per accounts allowed ledger.

The Court ordered that the Clerk issue new warrant in lieu of the one issued to Meador & Low No. 2614.

Upon a petition from School Dist. No. 12, Sabine County, Texas, it is ordered that an election be held on Saturday June the 19th. to determine whether or not the majority of the tax payers of said district desire to increase the school tax from .20 cents on the one hundred dollars valuation to .30 cents on the one hundred dollars valuation in said district.

The returns of an election held in School Dist. No. 18 were counted and the following result declared -

For School Tax-----14 votes.
 Against School Tax----- 2 "

It is therefore ordered by the Court that a tax of .25 cents on the one hundred dollars be levied, assessed and collected in said district.

It is ordered by the Court that a change be made in the public road near M.S. Parrish place and that the new road be placed on the new ground at the expense of the said M.S. Parrish.

It is ordered by the Court that School Dist. No. 27 be divided into two School Dist. and that the following boundaries constitute the field notes to School Dist. No. 27 - Beginning at the N.W. corner of J.A. Rogers home place on the N. boundary line of the Stone Smith League of land thence with the W. boundary line of the said J.A. Rogers to the N.W. corner of W.F. Arnold Sr. tract of land, thence South along the W. boundary line of the said Arnold tract to the House on Elizabeth Emer's tract of land, thence in a southerly direction with the West boundary line of said Emer tract of land to the intersection of the one. Halley and Stone Smith League lines, thence along and with the said Halley West boundary line to the S.W. corner of the Halley League, thence with the South boundary line of the said Halley League to its S.E. corner, thence East along the South boundary line of the said Halley League tract of land to its S.E. corner, thence in a Northerly direction with the East boundary line of the said Nicholas League line to its N.E. corner, thence in a westerly direction with the North boundary line of said Nicholas League line to its N.W. corner, thence S. along the W. boundary line of said Nicholas League line, on said line, thence in a S.W. direction 8000 yards to the S.E. corner of the Stone Smith League, thence N.W. along the N. boundary line of said Stone Smith League to the place of beginning.

The resignation of I.M. Courtney as Constable of Prec. No. 6 having been presented to the Court, the same was accepted and it is hereby ordered that from this date that I.M. Courtney is no longer held responsible for the said Constable work in said Precinct No. 6.

A petition from a number of citizens of Precinct No. 6 asking that the Court appoint George Green Constable of said Precinct No. 6 was presented to the

Court but after due consideration the request was refused by the Court.

It is hereby ordered by the Court that the following rate of taxation on the \$100.00 dollars valuation be levied, assessed and collected for the year 1915 on all taxable property in Sabine County, Texas.

The order heretofore made allowing Dr. W.L.Cooper at Fairdale to change the Public road at and near his home place is hereby rescinded and it is ordered that J.A.Hyden, Com. Prec. No. 2 take charge of the matter and place the road back on the old location.

It appearing to the Court that W.R.Hyden is indebted to Sabine County in the sum of \$210.03, said amount being the amount drawn as salary by the said W.R.Hyden as County Clerk of Sabine County during the years of 1911 and 1912 in excess of amount allowed by law, as reported by J.S.Goodrich and it further appearing to the Court that F.P. Adams seems to have overdrawn in the amount of \$291.75, said amount being the amount drawn as salary as Clerk for the years 1913 and 1914 in excess of the amount allowed by law, as reported by J.S.Goodrich, and it is hereby ordered by the Court that the County Attorney of Sabine County take the proper steps to adjust a settlement in the matter and if necessary to file suit for the adjustment of the matter.
