

The Commissioners Court met as a Board of Equalization June the 28th. 1915 with all members present.

The Court was opened by proclamation of the sheriff-

Present and presiding- J.B.Lewis County Judge. Geo. W. Terren Com. Prec. No. 1
J.A.Hyden Com. Prec. No. 2, L.T.Halbert, Com. Prec. No. 3 and C.M.Bennett Com. Prec.
No. 4. F.P.Adams Clerk and Jas. G. Berker, Sheriff.

The valuations as placed on the property was reduced as shown in the Minutes of said Court in Vol. 1. pages 199 to 212 inclusive.

The Court adjourned as a Board of Equalization July the 2nd. 1915 and the Commissioners Court was immediately opened by proclamation of the Sheriff.

Accounts were allowed as per accounts allowed Ledger.

Upon petition the following change was made in the Yellowpine and Bronson Road.

Beginning near Willis Conners home place thence to near the N.E. corner of the John Sadler survey so that the road will be placed on the land line between the property of Willis Conner and E. J. Partin.

The Court ordered the Clerk to issue each officer his per diem.

The Court adjourned to meet at the next regular term.
