

The Commissioners Court met in regular quarterly session August 9th. 1915 with the following members present - Hon. J.B. Lewis, County Judge, Geo. Herren Com. Prec. No. 1 J.A. Hyden, Com. Prec. No. 2, L.T. Halbert Com. Prec. No. 3, and C.H. Bennett, Com. Prec. No. 4, Jas. C. Barker, sheriff and T.P. Adams, Clerk.

Court was opened by proclamation of the sheriff.

The returns of the Amendment election held on the 24th. day of July came on to be counted and the following result was found -

The Court ordered the clerk to issue each election officer \$2.00 and the returning officers \$2.00 each for holding and returning the amendment election held on the 24th. day of July 1915.

Accounts were allowed as per accounts allowed ledger.

The Court allowed S.J. Hall \$21.00 for damage done to land by reason of passing of a Public road through his land and Geo. Herren was authorized to fence road through property of the parties at the expense of the County.

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The Court appointed J.T. Elliott as Constable of Precinct No. 6, at Bronson, Texas and he made a bond that was approved by the Court.

The Court allowed J.H. Bell and W.W. Low \$6.00 each and W.F. Martin \$3.00 for services as Jurors of View and ordered that the amounts be issued out of General County Fund.

The Court Allowed B. McDonald ~~6.00~~ \$6.00 and W.G. Ener Sr. and Lee McDaniel \$3.00 each for services as jurors of view to be issued out of the General County Fund.

The Court ordered that the Sheriff do not furnish any more Tobacco or Snuff to the County Prisoners at the expense of the County.

The Court allowed the County Judge a leave of absence from the County for the as long as three weeks if wanted.

The Court ordered that the Sheriff be allowed .40 cents per day for the feeding of each prisoner for the next quarter.
