Upon the returns of a Stock Law Election Held December the 11th. in a subdivision of Sabine County at Gravel Hill School House to determine whether or not Sheep, Goats and Hogs should run at large the following result was declared-

For Stock Law-----15 votes.

Against the Stock Law-----23 votes.

It being found that the Stock Law failed to carry it is the order of the Court that Stock be allowed to run at large in said sub-division.
