

The Commissioners Court met in regular monthly meeting January the 10th 1916
with the following members present:-

The Court was opened by proclamation of the Sheriff.

Accounts were allowed as per accounts Allowed Ledger.

The following matters were had to wit:

Upon petition the Court ordered that the Geneva Stock Law District line be extended so as to include 38 acres of land belonging to L. A. Fuller on the L. W. Warren survey in Sabine County, Texas.

Upon petition the Court ordered that the Geneva Stock Law District line be extended so as to include 111 acres of land belonging to C. B. Clark on the L. W. Warren survey in Sabine County, Texas.

Upon petition the Court ordered that the Geneva Stock Law District line be extended so as to include 100 acres of land belonging to H. P. Conn on the Jos. Mott survey in Sabine County, Texas.

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Upon petition the Court ordered that the Geneva Stock Law District line be extended so as to include 105 acres of land belonging to C.C. Kirk on the Jos. Mott survey in Sabine County, Texas.

Upon petition the Court ordered that the Geneva Stock Law District line be extended so as to include 100 acres of land on the J.I. Pirfimo survey in Sabine County, Texas belonging to O.H. Smith.

The Court ordered that Geo. W. Herren, Com. Beat No. 1, look into the Small Pox situation and take the matter up with Dr. C.F. Smith, the County Physician and do what is necessary to be done regarding the matter.

Upon petition signed by E.B. Smith and others asking that a Public road be opened up through T.W. Low's property near Sabinetown, the Court appointed a jury of view composed of T.C. Speights, D.B. Watson, and J.A. Ragan and requested that they report at the next meeting of the Com. Court.

The Court ordered that the Tax Collector be authorized to accept the taxes of Mrs. E.C. Travis at the rate and valuation of \$4.00 per acre instead of the amount that was placed on the unrendered roll.

The Court ordered the clerk to issue each officer his per diem.

The Court adjourned to meet at the next regular meeting.
