

Commissioners Court met in regular monthly session March the 13th. 1916 with the following members present-- J.B.Lewis County Judge, Geo. W. Nerren, Com. Beat No. 1, J.A.Hyden Com. Beat No. 2, L. T. Halbert Com. Beat No. 3 and C.M.Bennett Com. Beat No. 4, Jas. G. Barker, Sheriff and F.P.Adams Clerk.

The Court was opened by proclamation of the Sheriff.

Accounts were allowed as per accounts Allowed Ledger.

The Court ordered that G.E.Smith be exempt from Public Road service for one year on account of a broken arm.

The Court ordered that all property that does not join the original Stock Law territory and that has been added by order of the Court on petition be declared not under the Stock Law provision and that all orders passed in this connection be void.

Upon petition the Court ordered that the Stock Law Territory be extended in the Geneva subdivision so as to include 196 acres on the J.I.Firfirmo grant belonging to Mrs. D.H.Dean.

The Court ordered that all County Convicts be worked on the Public roads and that the Sheriff and County Attorney arrange for a guard and team.

Court ordered the Clerk to issue each officer his per diem.

The Court adjourned to meet at next regular meeting.
