

The State of Texas,
County of Sabine: WHEREAS, heretofore to-wit: on the 10th day of April 1916, a petition was presented to the Commissioners Court of Sabine county, Texas, signed by W.L. Fussell T.J. Walton and G.W. Jones asking that said commissioners court order an election to determine whether or not hogs sheep and goats shall be allowed to run at large within the following described subdivision of said county to-wit: Beginning on Labennalia creek at the North East corner of a fifty acre tract on the D. Renfro league owned by Henry Hutto said corner being on the west line of the Geneva stock law district. Thence in a westerly direction with the north line of said Hutto's 50 acres to his north west corner. Thence in a north westerly direction along the line of another 50 acres tract on said D. Renfros owned by Henry Hutto to the south east corner of a 50 acre tract on said survey owned by Tom Walton. Thence in a northerly direction with Walton's east line to his north east corner. Thence in a westerly direction along Walton's north line to his north west corner on the west boundary line of the David Renfro league. Thence northerly along the west line of David Renfro league to its north west corner. Thence easterly along the north boundary line of the David Renfro league to the most eastern corner of the E.A. Loyd survey. Thence northerly with the east boundary line of

of the E.A. Boyd to its north east corner. Thence westerly along the north boundary line of the E.A. Boyd to the county line of San Augustine and San Augustine county. Thence in a southerly direction with said San Augustine and Sabine county line to the south line to the north line of the E.N. Beall pre-emption same being the line of the present Geneva stock law district. Thence easterly with the north line of the E.N. Beall pre-emption to the David Renfro W.B. line Thence southerly with Renfro's W.B. line to the south west corner of the Renfro league Thence easterly with the S.B. line of David Renfro league to the S.E. corner of Henry Hutto's 50 acre tract on the Labennalia creek. Thence north westerly up the Labennalia creek to place of beginning. and it appearing to the court that the territory above described adjoins another subdivision of said county wherein the stock law is now in force and it further appearing to the court that a majority of the legally qualified free holding voters residing in the said above described subdivision of said county have signed said petition and it further appearing that said petition in all things in conformity with law, said petition was on the 10th day of April 1916 granted by the court and an election was on the 10th day of April 1916, ordered by said court to be held within said subdivision on the 20th day of May 1916 to determine whether or not hogs, sheep and goats shall be permitted to run at large within said subdivision of said county. NOW THEREFORE, I, J.B. Lewis County Judge, of said county, in my capacity as such hereby order that an election be held with the above described territory or subdivision of Sabine county on the 20th day of May 1916 at Red Oak Grove school House within said said territory for the purpose of determining whether or not hogs sheep and goats shall be permitted to run at large within said above described subdivision of Sabine county, and W.L. Fussell is appointed presiding officer of said election. All persons who are legally qualified voters and free holders residing within said above described subdivision shall be entitled to vote at said election. Notice of said election shall be given by publication of same in a newspaper published in Sabine county, for four successive weeks before the date of said election.
