Accounts were allowed as per Accounts Allowed Ledger.

The returns of a Special School Election ehld in School District No. 16 for increase of School Tax came on to be considered and the following result declared-

For Ingrese of Tax-----5 votes.

Against Increase of Tax-----6 votes.

It appearing to the Court that a greater number of the property tax paying voters, in said School Dist. No. 16 do not desire that their school tax be increased, it is ordered that the same tax be ~~levied~~, assessed and collected as before without an increase.

A motion was made by Halbert that the Court allow W.F.Fullen \$25.00 for a Roadway across his property and was seconded by Bennett and upon vote, Halbert and Bennett voted that he be allowed this amount and Nerren and Hyden voted against allowing the amount and J.B. Lewis voted that the amount be allowed and the Clerk was ordered to issue him warrant for the amount out of the Road and Bridge Fund.

It is ordered by the Court that .05 cents out of the .15 cent R. & B. Levy made for 1916 is hereby set aside and levied for the purpose of creating a Sinking Fund for Road and Bridge Refunding Warrants.

It is hereby ordered by the Court that the Treasurer of Sabine County set aside .11 cents out of all moneys collected in the Road and Bridge Fund Levy to be placed to the credit of the Road and Bridge Refunding Warrant Fund.
