

Commissioners Court met in regular monthly meeting December the 11th. 1916 with the following members present: - W.R. Cousins, County Judge, D.A. Beasley, Com. Beat No. 1, J.A. Hyden, Com. Beat No. 2, J.B. Hargrove, Com. Beat No. 3 and C.M. Bennett Com. Beat no. 4, C.B. Bright Sheriff and F.P. Adams, Clerk.

The Court was opened by proclamation of the Sheriff.

The following matters together with others were had to wit: -

Accounts were allowed as per Accounts Allowed Ledger.

The Court allowed John Harper, County School Supt. \$5.14 for stamps.

The Court appointed H.C. White as Constable of Precinct No. 4 upon his making the required bond and taking the Oath of office.

The Court ordered that the account presented to the Court by T.B. Hamilton in favor of the Remington Typewriter Co., be held over until the January term of said Court.

The Court ordered that the account of Jas. G. Barker for stamps and telephone bills be held over to next term.

The bond of J.M. Slocum as Constable of Precinct No. 2 was not approved on account of twenty days having elapsed before filing his bond.

Upon petition of the required number of signers asking for a stock law election in and about Milam as a subdivision to determine whether or not Sheep, Goats and Hogs shall be permitted to run at large, the Court ordered that an election be held in said subdivision January the 13th. 1917 ~~###~~ at Milam, Texas, in the Davidson store building with I.H. McGown as presiding officer and Draton Nethery and B.M. White as Judges.

The Court ordered the Clerk to cancel the Warrant for \$180.00 as issued to Hamilton and Hamilton for services rendered in assisting the Tax Collector in collecting delinquent taxes and the order heretofore made authorizing the payment of said claim is hereby rescinded.

The Court ordered the Clerk to issue W.H. Pratt a County Warrant for \$1.50 for summoning County Court Jurors for a special term.

The Court ordered the Clerk to issue to Jas. G. Barker a Warrant for his months salary as Sheriff of Sabine County.

The Court ordered the Clerk to issue each officer his per diem.

There being no further business the Court adjourned to meet at next regular meeting.
