

The Commissioners Court met this June 18th 1917 as a Board of Equalization with the following members present:

W.R. Cousins, County Judge, D.A. Easley, Com. Beat No. 1, J.A. Hyden, Com. Beat No. 2, J.B. Hargrove, Com. Beat No. 3 and C.M. Bennett, Com. Beat No. 4, C.B. Bright, Sheriff and F.P. Adams, Clerk.

The Court having instructed the Clerk to notify the different land and property owners of the raises in the valuation of said property, the Court went into the matter of hearing all parties as to why their property should not stand as raised.

The valuations stood as per the minutes of the Board of equalization.

On this June the 20th, there being no further business the Board of Equalization adjourned and the Commissioners Court was opened and the following matters had to wit:

The Court ordered the Clerk to issue a County Warrant for the amount of \$3.00 to J.W. Minton for a Certified Copy of the Hemphill Independent School Law.

Upon the returns of Trustees Election held in Common School District No. 20 the following Trustees were declared elected.

The Court allowed Mrs. V.H. Vickers \$5.00 as County Aid.

The Court allowed Mrs. J.W. Arnold \$5.00 as County Aid.

Accounts were allowed as per Accounts allowed Ledger.

The Court allowed J.B. Lewis \$20.00 for legal services in the case of Sabine County Vs. Chas. Standberg.

There being no further business the Court adjourned to meet at the next regular term.
