Court was opened by proclamation of the Sheriff.

The following matters were had together with others.

Upon Application of C. M. Whitehead and W. L. Whitehead to be relieved from the Official Bond of J. M. Slocum as constable of Precinct #5, Sabine County, Texas; the Court ordered the Clerk to issue the necessary notices in such cases.

The Court ordered that the order heretofore made exempting H. E. McGown from Public Road duty is hereby rescinded and it is ordered that H. E. McGown do his duty as a Road hand.

W. A. Easley having failed to qualify as constable of Precinct #1 the Court appointed W. H. Pratt as constable upon his executing an Official Bond.

The Court ordered that a fund be opened on Books of County mechanics to be known as Road & Bridge Highway Fund in which to place the funds received from the State Highway Department as one-half Registering Fees on Automobiles.

The Court allowed Mrs. Kit Smith \$5.00 as County Aid.

T. L. Hargrove having presented an account of \$100.00 for damage to property on farm,

The Court voted to allow him \$12.50 as damage to said property.

The Court Granted the Wood order of 22 cords 20" Pine Wood to A. O. Easley, A. A. Barr and S. L. Beckcom at \$3.45 per cord delivered on Court Yard to be measured in the Woods by D. A. Easley.

Upon the Bid of P. H. Browning to furnish water to the tank at Jail at the rate of \$170.00 per year. The Court ordered that he carry out his contract.

Upon Petition of E. R. Fuller and ten others asking for a Stock Law Election to be held in a subdivision of Sabine County. The Court ordered that said Election be held on Nov. 3, 1917, at Ruddell School House in said subdivision and that W. F. Fullen be appointed Presiding Officer and John Roberts and E. G. Cobb as Judges.

The Court allowed J. B. Rodgers, Sheriff of Newton County \$10.00 for bringing attached witnesses to County Court.

The Court Approved the Official Bond of W. H. Pratt as constable of Precinct No. 1 Sabine County, Texas.

The Court allowed F. P. Adams \$15.00 for amount paid S. W. Eddings for exemption claims.

The Tax assessor presented the Tax Rolls for 1917 as compiled, for approval and the Court approved Rolls as compiled and allowed the Assessor the Sum of \$784.55 as fees for assuming the County Taxes.

The Court ordered the Clerk to charge the Tax Collector with the following amounts under the different Funds.

Total State Tax \$27184.80

The Court allowed Mrs. Joe Horton \$5.00 and Mrs. Randal \$5.00.

There being no further business the Court Adjourned to meet at next regular meeting.
