Court was opened by proclamation of the Sheriff.

Accounts were allowed as per Accounts Allowed Ledger.

W. R. Cousins made his quarterly report and the same was approved by the Court.

Upon a petition with the required number of signers asking for a Special School
Tax Election to be held in Common School Dist. No. 27 to determine whether or not a special
Tax of .50 cents on the \$100.00 valuation on all taxable property in said District shall be
assessed
levied ~~assessed~~ and collected for the purpose of supplementing the State School fund in said
District and the Court ordered that said Election be granted and be held at Talltimber
Texas, on January 4th, 1918 and that W. T. Smith be appointed as Presiding Officer.

The Court ordered that the part of the Hemphill and Geneva Road leaving the Bronson
Road at T. C. Hight's place and running South about One Mile to the Bronson and Milan Road
be discontinued.

There being no further business the Court ordered the Clerk to issue each officer
his per diem and that the Court stand recessed subject to call of the County Judge.
