

County of Sabine. On this the 22nd day of December 1917, the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, being in Special Session at a special term of said Court, all the members of said Court, to-wit:

being present, came on to be considered the returns of an election held on the 15th day of

December 1917, to determine whether or not the bonds of said County should be issued to the amount of Five hundred Thousand (\$500,000.00) Dollars, bearing interest at the rate of five and one-half per cent per annum, payable semi-annually, said Bonds to mature serially, not to exceed thirty years from their date; for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating macadamized, gravelled or paved roads and turnpikes, or in aid thereof, and whether or not a tax shall be levied, assessed and collected in said County of Sabine, sufficient to pay the current interest on said Bonds and to provide the required sinking fund to redeem them at maturity; and it appearing that said election was in all respects lawfully held, and said returns duly and legally made, and that there were cast at said election 802 votes, of which 631 votes were cast "For the issuance of Bonds and levying of the tax in payment therefor", and 171 votes cast "Against the issuance of Bonds and levying of the tax in payment therefor".

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND DECLARED that the proposition to issue said Bonds and levy said tax was sustained by a two-thirds majority of the qualified property tax-payers voting at said election, and that the Commissioners' Court of the said County is authorized to issue said Bonds, and to levy and have assessed and collected said tax.
