

The Commissioners' Court met in regular monthly meeting January 17th, 1918 with the following members present:-

W. R. Cousins, County Judge.

D. A. Basley, Com. Beat No. 1.

J. B. Hargrove, Com. Beat No. 3.

C. M. Bennett, Com. Beat No. 4.

W. H. Pratt, Constable and F. P. Adams, Clerk.

The Court was opened by proclamation of the Sheriff and the following matters together with others were had:-

The Court rescinded the order heretofore made discontinuing that part of the Hemphill and Geneva Road at and near O.H. Smith's place.

The Court ordered that the lands of G.W. Oliphint on the E. Clark League survey that were placed on the unrendered rolls for 1917 be assessed and collected on at the rate of \$3.00 per acre.

The Court ordered that the lands of R.W. Henry and W.V. Whitfield on the John Gilbert League survey that were placed on the unrendered rolls for 1917 be assessed and collected on at the rate of \$3.00 per acre.

The Court ordered that a Special School Tax election be held in Camp Springs School Dist. no. 27 on February 15th, 1918 at Talltimber Texas, for the purpose of determining whether or not a majority of the property tax paying voters in said District desire to tax themselves at the rate of 50 cents on the \$100.00 valuation on all taxable property in said District to supplement the state apportionment in said District and W.T. Smith is hereby appointed manager of said Election.

Upon the returns of a Special School Tax election held in Common School Dist. No. 28, for the purpose of determining whether or not a majority of the property tax paying voters in said District desired to tax themselves at the rate of 50 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property in said District and the following result was declared:-

For School Tax-----3 votes.

Against School Tax---1 vote.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that a tax of and at the rate of 50 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property in said District be levied, assessed and collected.

Upon motion duly made and seconded, the Court appointed G.W. Alford as Sheriff and Tax Collector of Sabine County to fill the vacancy made by the death of C.B. Bright.

The Court allowed the following parties county aid. Mr. Randal \$5.00, Bud Giles \$10.00, T.F. Sparks \$5.00, Miss Nann Howard \$15.00 and Mrs. Boaz \$5.00.

The Court ordered that the Clerk prepare a Cost Bill in the case of A.A. Wilson vs. Sabine County and pay off the judgment and cost in said case.

The Court ordered the Clerk to issue each officer his per diem.

The Court adjourned to meet January 22, 1918.
