The Court ordered that the Clerk issue to the County Judge \$150.00 out of the General County Fund for the purpose of having the transcript in the Road Bond Issue prepared according to law by some competent Bond Attorney.

The Court recommended that an election precinct be established at Remlig, Sabine County, Texas, at the August Term of this Court and the Court requested the County Judge to ask the Democratic Chairman for Sabine County to arrange for an election to be held there in July primaries.

The Court contracted with B.L. Bardwell to paint the roofs of the Courthouse and Jail and agreed to pay him \$125.00 for the work, he to use first class Roof paint on each building.

The Court allowed the following parties county aid- Mr. Randal \$5.00, Bud Giles \$5.00, Mrs. Boaz \$5.00 and Mrs. Nannie Meador \$5.00.

The Court approved all officers report for past quarter.

The Court allowed the County Officers their salaries for past quarter.

The Court ordered the clerk to issue each officer his per diem.

The Court adjourned to meet February 23rd, 1918.
