

The Commissioners Court met in regular monthly meeting April the 8th. 1918 with all members present.

The Court was opened by proclamation of the Sheriff.

Accounts were allowed as per Accounts Allowed Ledger.

L. Ware Justice of the Peace of Precinct No. 3, Sabine County, Texas, filed his resignation as Justice of the Peace of said Precinct and the Court accepted his resignation.

The Court appointed E.L. Dean as Justice of the Peace of Precinct No. 3, caused by the resignation of ~~L. Ware~~ L. Ware upon the said E.L. Dean executing the required official Bond. Upon petition of H.E. McGown, C.H. Smith and O.K. Tiley the Court placed their lands that are located on the J. Pirfimo survey in the Stock Law subdivision.

Upon the petition of the required number of qualified tax paying voters in School District No. 37 asking that an election be held in said Dist. to determine whether or not a majority of the qualified voters in said Dist. desire to tax themselves a tax of and at the rate of .50 cents on the \$100.00 valuation on all taxable property in said Dist. to supplement the State apportionment for said Dist. and the Court ordered that said election be granted and held on May the 11th, 1918, at the School house in said Dist. and that S.T. Mason be appointed presiding officer of said election.

There being no further business the Court adjourned to meet April the 12th.
