J. A. Eyden made a motion the increase the Tax Levy of the Sabine County Road Bond' Mund of Sabine County. Texas, from eighty, .80 cents on the One-Hurdred Dollars valuation as Tevied in said Bond order, to an amount not to exceed Ninety .90 cents on the One-Hundred Dollars valuation on all taxable property in Sabine County, Texas and the motion; was seconded by J. B. Hargroves and said motion was carried unanimous, and the Court so, ordered.

The Court ordered the Clerk to issue each officer his per diem.
There being no further business the Court adjourned this May the 27th 1918.
