

Commissioners Court met in regular monthly meeting June the 10th. 1918 with the following members present-

The Court was opened by proclamation of the Sheriff.

Accounts were allowed as per Accounts Allowed Ledger.

The following matters together with others were had to wit:-

Upon a petition signed by the required number of property tax paying voters in Common School Dist. No. 23, asking that a Special Election be held in said Dist. for the purpose of determining whether or not a majority of the property tax paying voters desire to tax themselves at the rate of .50 cents on the \$100.00 valuation on all Taxable property in said Dist. for the purpose of supplementing the state apportionment for said Dist. and the Court ordered that said Election be held July the 13th. 1918 at the School house in said Dist. and that V. E. Vickers be appointed presiding officer.

Upon a petition signed by the required number of property tax paying voters in School Dist. no. 38 asking that a Special School Tax election be held in said Dist. for the purpose of determining whether or not a majority of the Tax paying voters in said District desire to tax themselves .50 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property in said Dist. for the purpose of supplementing the State apportionment for said Dist. the Court ordered that an Election be held on July the 13th. 1918 and that J. W. Dorsey be appointed presiding officer.

The Court ordered that the School Trustees of Fairdale School Dist. no. 25 be authorized to sell the old school building to highest bidder.

The Court appointed W. H. Minton, R. S. Noble and T. J. Hickley as a Jury of View to look over and assess the damage to property of parties by reason of the Bronson and Tebo road passing over their premises.

The Court allowed each officer his per diem.

The Court allowed each County officer his monthly

There being no further business the Court adjourned.
