The Court was opened by proclamation of the Sheriff.

Accounts were allowed as per Accounts Allowed Ledger.

The following matters together with others were had to wit-

Upon the returns of a Special School Tax Election held in Common School Dist. No. 32 on August 10th. 1918 the following result was declared-

For School Tax-----31 votes.

Against School Tax-----20 votes.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that a tax of and at the rate of .50 cents on the \$100.00 valuation on all taxable property in said Dist. be levied, assessed and collected. *The Court ordered that the following Tax Levy be made on the 100% valuation on all taxable property for the year 1918. General County, 25 cents. Road Bridge, 15 cents. Jail, 25 cents. Road Bond, 10 cents.*

Upon motion duly made and seconded the Court ordered that the County pay the amount of \$25.00 on each dipping vat put in the County for the purpose of paying for the solution and paying for the expense of having said solution properly mixed.

The Court approved the quarterly report of W. H. Davidson, County Treasurer.

The Court allowed Jim Giles \$5.00 as County Aid.

The Court ordered the Clerk to issue each officer his monthly salary.

The Court ordered the Clerk to issue each officer his per diem.

There being no further business the Court adjourned.
