Upon the returns of a Special School Tax Election held in Common School Dist. No. 12, held on the 17th. day of August 1918, the following result was declared-

For increase of School tax-----13 votes.
Against increase of School Tax----- 5 "

It is therefore ordered by the Court that a tax of and at the rate of .50 cents on the \$100.00 valuation be levied, assessed and collected on all taxable property in said District.

The Plans and profiles of the Sabine County Roads were approved as prepared by L. Acker, County Engineer and the Court ordered the Clerk to issue Warrant to L. Acker for \$6000.00 to cover the contract price.

There being no further business the Court adjourned.
