

Commissioners Court met in regular monthly meeting October 14th, 1918 with the following members present:

- W. R. Cousins, County Judge.
- D. A. Easley, Com. Beat No. 1.
- J. A. Hyden, Com. Beat No. 2.
- J. B. Hargroves, Com. Beat No. 3.
- C. M. Bennett, Com. Beat No. 4.
- G. W. Alford, Sheriff and F. P. Adams, Clerk.

Court was opened by proclamation of the Sheriff.

The following matters together with others were had to wit:

Accounts were allowed as per Accounts Allowed Ledger.

The First National Bank, Depository for Sabine County, Texas reported the amount of interest due the County on daily balances as per contract and bid as Depository which amounted to \$1223.40 which was ordered distributed as follows:

To Available School Fund for 1916-1917-----	\$310.80
To available School Fund for 1917-1918-----	689.20
To General County Fund-----	223.40

Upon petition the Court appointed W. W. Berryman as Justice of the Peace and W. E. Donohoe as Constable of Precinct No. 3, at Prockeland, Texas.

Upon the returns of a Special Stock Law Election held in a subdivision of Sabine County on the Jos. Walker 3/4 of a league on the 12th day of October 1918 the following result was declared:

For Stock Law-----	15 Votes.
Against Stock Law-----	33

It appearing to the Court that a majority of the property tax paying voters residing within said subdivision desire to allow Stock to run at large in said subdivision, it is therefore ordered by the Court that stock be allowed to run at large in said subdivision on the Jos. Walker 3/4 of a league.

The Court ordered the Clerk to issue to each officer his per diem.

There being no further business the Court adjourned.
