The above parties appearing to have received the largest majority of the votes polled in said General Election as shown by the Presiding Officers of each Precinct, the Court declared them elected and ordered the County Judge to issue to each of them a certificate of election.

The quarterly report of the County Treas. was filed and approved.

John F. Whitehead filed his official Bond as Constable of Precinct No. 2, and same was approved by the Court and he took the oath of office.

T. J. Bickley having been appointed by the Court a member of the Jury of View to lay out and assess damage on Bronson and Tebo road and having failed to qualify as such Juror, the Court appointed H. L. Pratt in his place.

There being no further business the Court adjourned to meet December the 2nd 1918 at which time the Official Bonds of the various County and Precinct officers as shown elected in the General Election will be approved by the Court.
