

Commissioners Court met in regular session Dec. 9, 1918. The following members:

The court was opened by proclamation of the sheriff. The following matters were had to wit: The court ordered the sheriff to notify each ferry man on the Sabine river to make the necessary application and necessary bond. The court allowed Sabine Citizen Co. 1.20 phone rent upon petition of order required no votes. Justice precinct #2 the court appointed J. E. Ray as Justice of Peace in and for Justice precinct 2 Sabine Co. Texas.

The report of W. H. Minton H. L. Pratt & R. S. Noble Juror of reviewers appointed by the court to review a part of road leading from Bronson to Tebo Tex. and assessed the damages to land owners come on to be considered and the following report was approved by the court the land of W. H. Garlington valued at \$10.00 per acre & raised to \$15.00 per acre The bottom land T. L. Hargrove was valued at \$35.00 per acre. and the up land of T. L. Hargrove valued at \$15.00 per acre. The land of T. M. Anderson was valued at \$15.00 per acre & \$50.00 was allowed for damages for passing through T. M. Anderson field. E. A. Chambers was valued at \$15.00 per acre the above valuation to cover the land taken by the public road and the court ordered the same to be paid upon the actual acreage to the figured & submitted by L. Acker at the next term of court.

The court ordered that advertisement for bids for the construction for Sabine County roads be sent to the Houston Post, The Dallas News & Shreveport Times to be run 10 days in each paper. The bids to be received at special meeting the Com. Court to be held Jan. 6, 1919 upon petition of a majority citizen the following change was made on Milan & Sabine town road. Beginning at a point about one quarter of a mile East of the John Morris place and about three hundred yards north of the present Bridge across the Pologocho creek thence in an easterly direction with the old original road down the Pologocho creek about one mile and one half to a point opposite the Ben Dorsey place at the mouth of Pologocho creek.

Court ordered that nothing toward paying regular janitor be allowed.

The court allowed Green Randle \$5.00 County aid and Mrs. J. W. Arnold \$5.00 county aid.
