The Court was opened by proclamation of Sheriff. The following matters together with others were had. Accounts were advanced as per Accounts allowed ledger. Cordray's place was received and after due consideration the report was rejected and the court appointed the following jury of view to go upon the road April 5, 1919 and report at next regular meeting.

The Court sold an unused old record to the Masons for \$10.00. Upon petition the Court ordered that 350 acres of land being to Jas. McMichel and 284 1/2 acres of land belonging to T. L. Hargroves and 61 acres belonging to Liser Hoggan and 50 acres belonging to M. Humphery and 45 acres belonging to L. J. Fullen, be placed in the Geneva Stock low. Subdivision:-

Upon petition the Court Granted the following Third Class Road, beginning at Homer Rogans place and then W. W. by John Zogen place and thence by W. W. Lewis place and thence to intersect Pineland and Turpentine Road at N. A. Whitehead place.

The court allowed T. L. Hargroves \$55.00 right of way.

The Court allowed W. H. Garlington \$32.25 for 2 15/100 acres of land for right of way for County Road across his land.

The Court Appointed J. K. Williams Justice of Peace of Brookeland Texas.
