The Court was opened by Proclamations of Sheriff G. W. Alford, the court allowed County and to J. W. Arnold and amount of \$500.

Upon petition by the majority of the patrons of common school No. 8, asking that a special election be held in said common School Dist. No. 8, for the purpose to determine whether or not a majority of the property tax paying voters in said Dist. desire to increase the maintenance from 20 cents to 100.00 valuation on all taxable property in said Dist. court granted the election and ordered that it be held May 17, 1919 at the School house in said Dist. and G. C. Smith be appointed presiding officer of said election. The Court granted the following change in the Bronson and Isaac road, upon petition.

Beginning at T. C. Crouches house and said road and thence south about 4 miles intersecting the original road at Carters Carleton place.

Upon motion duly made and seconded the court noted to carry \$8000.00 tornado insurance on court house and \$2000.00 tornado insurance and Jail house for 3 years the \$1000.00 to cost \$75.00 for 3 years. M. T. Bell Commissioner Beat No. 2, voted against the proposition.

Upon petition asking that a part of the Fairmount and Brookeland made be discontinued as follows: at the cross road east of L. L. Bradshaws place to the Ambros Martin place, the court upon motion duly made and seconded the court voted to discontinue the said used as for petition.

Accounts were allowed as for accounts allowed ledger.

The court voted to condoning the land on U. J. Edwards place that is required to list class public road 60 feet wide after having gone to the land and failing to agree on a price and the court appointed W. H. Minton, W. H. Davidson and J. W. Tatom as a jury of view to go upon the premises and assess the damage and they were ordered to meet April 19, 1919.

It is ordered and agreed by the court the county officers have free access over phones lines for county business as the county road right of ways cleared as intended contracted when the county bought the three shares of stock in the Telephone Co. County officers having officers in court house and county commissioners.

Upon order of the court the county is to pay to the Sabine Citizen Telephone Co. \$100.00 and Smith Bros. the contract and to pay to the Sabine Citizen Tel. Co. \$1000 for taking down and putting up Telephone lines and all roads in county and the Telephone co. is to work the taking down and putting up of lines behind the contractors.

The court ordered that the County Engineer Survey 5 1/2 miles of the Geneva & Carters ferry road beginning an east side of road at Geneva Texas, and runing east 5 1/2 miles.

The court ordered that the Hemphill and Fairdale road be classed as a first class road instead of a second class road as it now stands.

The court advanced that a Warrant for \$127.90 be issued to G. W. Alford in payment for 1915-1916 & 1917 delinquent tax competition as compiled by Mrs. Harges of Austin Texas.

The court ordered the Clerk to issue to T. M. Anderson \$50.00 as damage to land as per report of Jury of View for road passing over his land.
